

Chapter I

Safety Precautions



Warning: Be aware of risks that could result in death, serious personal injury, or significant property damage.

During operation, the front, sides, and top of the machine will have an elevated temperature. Areas labeled with a symbol indicate that the surface will become hot during operations, please be careful to prevent hurns



Attention: Be aware or risks that could result in personal injury or property damage.

- 1. This product is designed and intended for home use, please refrain from using it for other purposes.
- 2. This product is not intended to be operated by persons (including children) who may lack the physical, sensory, or mental faculties required to do so or lack experience. unless under the strict supervision of individuals responsible for their safety or guidance. Please prevent children from playing with the machine in any circumstance to ensure their safety.
- 3. After opening the packaging, please immediately throw any plastic bags into the trash as to prevent children from playing with them.
- 4. This product is designed for use with a voltage of 120V and a frequency of 60Hz. Prior to connecting the power supply, please check that the local power voltage is appropriate. A voltage higher or lower than the rated voltage may damage the machine or affect its functionality. To prevent causing damage to the machine, it is recommended to use a voltage stabilizer.
- 5. This product is a Class I Electrical Appliance. Please ensure that the grounding wire is properly grounded prior to use to avoid electrical leakage accidents.
- 6. It is necessary to only use 15A or higher grounded sockets and to securely connect the power plua completely to prevent overheating which may cause short-circuiting, fire hazards, and other dangers.
- 7. Do not operate the product with an external timer or independent remote control system to prevent short-circuiting, combustion, and other dangers.
- 8. This product is intended for grilling purposes. Do not use this product to boil water, cook porridge, fry, or other functions to prevent short circuiting and property damage.
- 9. Do not plug or unplug the machine into a power socket with wet hands to prevent getting shocked.

- 10. Please use the machine on a flat, level surface. Do not set up the machine on top of carpet, a towel, plastic, paper, or other flammable materials to prevent the risk of combustion
- 11. Do not set up the machine on uneven, wet, hot, slippery, or heat sensitive surfaces to prevent potential injury or property damage.
- 12. Do not put this product near high temperatures, strong magnets, flammable or explosive gases (natural gas, methane, etc.) to prevent damage to the machine and risks of combustion. Maintain a distance of at least 10cm from it and its surrounding objects.
- 13. Do not use this product under or near flammable materials such as curtains or closets to prevent fire hazards
- 14. Never operate machine operate without anyone overseeing the procedure to prevent burning food and fire hazards.
- 15. Ensure that the power cord is not in contact with sharp objects or hot surfaces and objects to prevents risks of electrical leakage, electrical shock, and fire hazards.
- 16. This product is not designed to handle extended operation with no food inside, doing so may result in cracking the pan or igniting the machine, potentially causing injury or property damage. It is not recommended to use the machine continuously for more than 3 hours.
- 17. Do not use excessive force when lifting the lid to prevent the pan from bouncing back and colliding with or burning the user.
- 18. When using the machine, do not put any bagged, canned, or bottled items on the pan to prevent risks of exploding.
- 19. When using the machine, do not put very sharp objects, paper, plastic, or other flammable materials in the pan to prevent risks of property damage and fire hazards
- 20. Do not touch the pan with your bare hands during operation or afterwards before the machine has cooled down to prevent burns.
- 21. Please use the included bamboo spatula while cooking. Do not use metal or sharp objects to scrape the surface to prevent damage to the product.
- 22. Please quickly clean oil spills to avoid oil from seeping into the machine's interior. preventing risks short-circuiting, electrical shock, and damage to or loss of property.
- 23. Be careful when removing food from the machine as it will be very hot.
- 24. Do not use knives or metal tools to cut food on the pan; Do not use metal or rough materials to clean the pan as it may damage the coating.
- 25. After completing operations, unplug the power cord, wait until the machine has cooled down, then clean the pan as well as the surface. Residual scraps of food and arease may create smoke or fire hazards in later use.


- 26. After using the machine, the surface of the pan will have residual heat. Wait until the machine has cooled down before proceeding to clean to prevent burns.
- 27. When cleaning or moving the machine, when the machine malfunctions, or when the machine is not being used, unplug the power cord to prevent electrical leakage.
- 28. When unplugging the power grip, maintain a firm grip on the plug and refrain from using excessive force as to not damage the cord and present a risk of electric leakage.
- 29. If the power cord is damaged, to ensure personal safety, it is necessary to contact the manufacturer or professional repair and maintenance personnel to replace the component.
- 30. Do not rinse or submerse this product in water or other liquids or spray the machine with alcohol to avoid damaging the product or creating electric leakage.



After selecting the desired function, press the "+" or "- "buttons to adjust the time setting. Press the "heating method" to select if the heat is applied through the top pan, bottom pan, or both. The heat adjustment knob may be used to set different specific temperatures (this is only available when using the "manual grilling" function).


Remarks

The durations in the above table is for reference only. The appropriate times required should be adjusted relative to voltage, temperature, ingredients, hardness, size and other factors. The customary names of each dish may also vary based on different regions and cultures, and settings should be adjusted according to the actual situation.

- 5. When the cooking is finished, the machine will emit beeping noises to indicate completion before transitioning back to standby mode.
- 6. After using the machine, disconnect the power switch, unplug the power cable, wait a few minutes for the machine to cool down and use a damp towel to wipe down the pans. If the machine will remain in storage for an extended period, use dishwashing detergent to sanitize the pans.


Upper Pan 180° Levelling Method

Lift the upper pan to a vertical position so that it is perpendicular to the base. Grip the handle and gently lift upwards until the pan is removed from its socket and let the pan naturally continue rotating until the handle connects with the flat surface and is supporting the weight of upper half, at which point an angle of 180° is reached (as pictured below)



Pan Ejection Method:

Open the pan to a 95° or 180° angle and press the pan ejection button. Grab and remove the pan after it pops out from its standard position (as pictured below).



Pan Installation Method:

Open the pan to a 95° or 180° angle, insert the lower pan into the socket towards the back of the machine before pressing the pan downwards into its correct position. There will be an audible click as it falls into place.



Tips

- To ensure the healthiness of the food, please refrain from reusing oil when cooking.
- 2. When making tortillas, it is recommended to flip sides once during cooking to ensure the top and bottom surfaces are consistent.

Chapter IV Cleaning and Maintenance

- Disconnect the power switch and unplug the power cable before cleaning the machine.
- After the pan has cooled down, use a damp towel to wipe the pan clean. The bottom pan is removable for cleaning. Please do not use steel wool or other rough objects to scrub the pan as it may damage the coating. If the machine will remain in storage for an extended period, use dishwashing detergent to sanitize the pans.
- Do not submerse the entire electric baking pan (electric grill) in water during cleaning to prevent the risks of electrocution and damage to the machine.
- When finished cleaning, wait until the machine is dry before storing it in a cool and dry place.


